

Discipline Reporting and Volleyball BC Sanctions Policy

Effective August 31, 2026 • Applies to the 2027 season and until replaced

The Club may use proportionate corrective or disciplinary measures when a participant breaches these policies, a team rule, facility requirement or an applicable governing-body policy. Procedural fairness will be provided in accordance with the seriousness and urgency of the matter.

Possible Club responses

- verbal or written education, coaching, warning or behavioural agreement;
- restorative or corrective action where appropriate and accepted by those involved;
- temporary restrictions, suspension from activities, removal from a role or team, or termination of participation;
- financial responsibility permitted under the Refunds Fines and Financial Penalties Policy; and
- referral or reporting to Volleyball BC, Volleyball Canada, a facility, law enforcement, child protection or another appropriate authority.

Mandatory Volleyball BC commitments

Reporting commitment. Titans Volleyball Club will inform Volleyball BC in writing at reporting@volleyballbc.org of any disciplinary sanction imposed by the Club against an individual registered with Volleyball BC.

Sanction-recognition commitment. Titans Volleyball Club will uphold and enforce any Volleyball BC sanction against a Volleyball BC-registered individual when the Club is notified of that sanction.

The Club will handle disciplinary information with appropriate confidentiality while making the disclosures necessary to meet governing-body, safety and legal obligations. A Club response does not prevent Volleyball BC or another authority from conducting its own process or imposing additional measures.
