

Player Code of Conduct

Effective August 31, 2026 • Applies to the 2027 season and until replaced

Every Titans athlete is expected to represent the Club with effort, respect, accountability and sportsmanship. By accepting a roster position, each athlete agrees to:

- Follow the Volleyball BC Code of Conduct and Ethics, applicable Safe Sport policies, facility rules, team expectations and Club policies.
- Treat teammates, coaches, officials, volunteers, opponents, families and facility staff with dignity and respect.
- Attend and arrive prepared for practices, competitions and team commitments. Communicate absences or lateness as early as reasonably possible.
- Give consistent effort, accept appropriate coaching and contribute to a team-first environment, including when disappointed about a role, result or playing time.
- Use respectful language and behaviour. Bullying, hazing, harassment, discrimination, threats, violence and retaliation are prohibited in person and online.
- Protect the physical and emotional safety of others. Follow training instructions and immediately report an injury, unsafe condition or serious concern.
- Do not possess, use, distribute or be impaired by alcohol, cannabis, illegal drugs or prohibited performance-enhancing substances during Club activities or travel.
- Use social media and team communications responsibly. Do not post humiliating, discriminatory, threatening, sexualized or confidential content involving the Club or its participants.
- Care for uniforms, equipment, facilities and accommodations and return Club property when requested.
- Compete honestly and uphold the rules and spirit of volleyball, including respectful interaction with officials and opponents.
